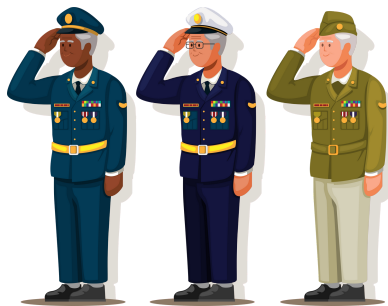

Geese rotate roles, they encourage the leader and empower others to lead. For the lead goose in the formation, 'drag' is high.
