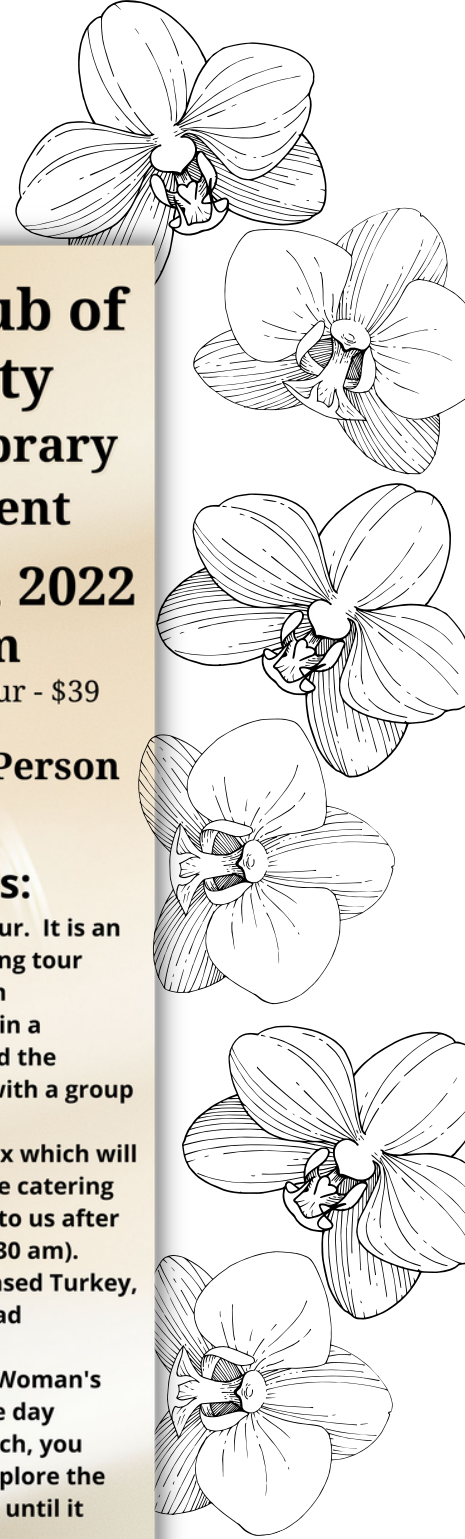


Supporting Temple City's History
