Dear Members of the Women's Club of Temple City,

Thank you for letting us come and speak to your executive board today. We hope to provide some general background information that may be shared with your members at your next general meeting.

The Boy Scouts of America has re-branded itself and is now called Scouts BSA. They have also changed their bylaws to allow girl's troops to form starting on February 1st. I am currently an Assistant Scoutmaster of a local boy's troop and we have been approached by a number of girls who are interested in starting a Girl's Troop. BSA requires that Girl Troops have a separate charter and scout master for their troop. I have agreed to serve as the scoutmaster for the perspective Girl's Troop and to help them find a charter organization which is interested in supporting them in this groundbreaking effort.

We are reaching out to you to ask if The Women's Club of Temple City would be interested in being the charter organization for a Girl's BSA Troop. We currently have ten girls who are interested in being founding members. As a chartering organization there are different levels of involvement and resource models we could follow. At minimum we need an organization that is willing to sign our charter and designate a representative to meet with us a couple times a year and share the vision of your organization with the young women in the Girl's Troop. If the Women's Club is open to additional support we are eager to partner with you to whatever level of involvement your organization is interested in having. Once chartered all insurance for activities and meetings are covered by BSA policies. Financially our troop will work to be self-sufficient and will hold our own fundraisers. We are eager to provide service and support for the Women's Club as part of our partnership.

These girls have a very clear vision of why they want to be pioneers of this program and I think your Executive Board would be very impressed by their poise and dedication. Please let us know if we can answer any additional questions you might have.
