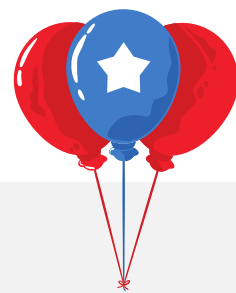
Thank you again for your confidence in electing me as your President. I'm looking forward to sharing this year with you.
