## *Getting to Know You – “Carol Daugherty”*



It is unlikely that you can attend at Woman’s Club of Temple City event and not see Carol Daugherty. Not only has she been a member since 2010, but she is also our direct liaison with the Temple City Historical Society. Here is a little bit about Carol:

Carol was born in Dayton Ohio and came to California in 1947 at the age of 7. She attended schools in Arcadia, Alhambra, and finally Temple City where she graduated in 1959. TCHS is also where she met her soon to be husband, James “Hoyt” Daugherty and they were married on March 10, 1961. They had three children together: Ruth, Glenn and James II; four grandchildren: Desiree, James Ryan, David and Jeannette; and three great-grandchildren: Jeannette, Chloe, and Jace. After 48 years of marriage, Carol lost Hoyt when he passed away in November of 2009.

While we know Carol primarily from her membership with the Woman's Club where she has served as secretary, historian, and our opening presenter; all of which culminated in her being recognized with the Woman's Club Humanitarian Award, there is so much more that Carol is involved in today. She has served as president, vice president, secretary, and museum docent director for the Temple City Historical Society, she works with the Temple City Coalition for the Homeless serving Sunday night dinners at the Temple City First United Methodist Church. She has been a member of the church since 1985 serving on various church committees, including acting as interim office secretary.

Her past work and volunteer experiences are as varied as Carol herself and include volunteering at La Rosa Elementary School as parent aide, library aide, and noon aide. She was crossing guard for the City at Cloverly School, drove a Russell Transportation School Bus for mentally handicapped student to school in San Gabriel, worked at Singer Sewing Machine Company in their Pasadena Corporate Office, NationsBank corporate office in Pasadena which later became Bank of America. She was Cub Scout Den Leader and Roundtable Commissioner for the Lucky Baldwin District receiving the Award of Merit, and a Boy Scout Troop Leader. She took Citizens Academy classes and volunteers for the Los Angeles County Sheriff's Department. Recently she served as a member of the Senior Master Plan Advisory Committee, an Election Inspector, and still volunteers as a poll worker.

Carol's hobbies include creative writing, including stories and poetry. She published her own book in 2013 FROM THE HEART, as well as some anthologies. She enjoys handcrafting, volunteering, and genealogy. She has an African Spur Tortoise given to her by her grandchildren names Miss Myrtle.

For all of the above, the City of Temple City named Carol as the 2019 Outstanding Older American for the City of Temple City where she was honored at a luncheon provided by the County of Los Angeles and a dinner provided by the City of Temple City. Thank you, Carol, for your years of service to our community. This recognition is well deserved!

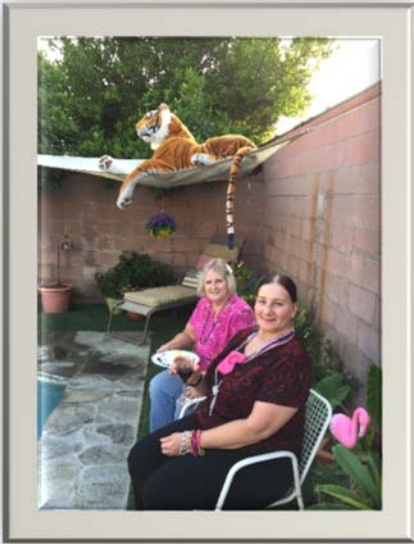
