I look forward to seeing everyone's creations as the historic Woman's Club of Temple City begins its 95th year!


Yearbook

Technology Practice

The Woman's Club Board has had several meetings on Zoom since March, but we realize that not everyone may have had the opportunity to use this technology, so Dawn is going to have a "no pressure" practice session. You can pop in anytime on Wednesday, September 9th from 7:00 pm to 8:00 pm to see how it works.



You can access a Zoom meeting with video from your phone, tablet, or computer by downloading the application (aka App) at <https://zoom.us/download>. If you don't want to do this, in the email there will be several phone numbers listed. You can call into the Zoom meeting and experience an old fashioned "party line" call. An email with all of this information will be sent to you from dawntarin@hotmail.com on Tuesday, September 8th.



In addition to Zoom, we will be using an application (aka App) called Kahoot. This application is new to Dawn too, and she will be experimenting with it during the September 9th practice meeting. The website to download the App is Kahoot.com. The City is holding a Trivia contest which will use this application and they recommend that Kahoot be used on a different device than the Zoom application, if you are using them together - which would be the idea for us. So, we suggest that you download Kahoot onto a

phone or iPad and Zoom on a computer if this is available to you.
