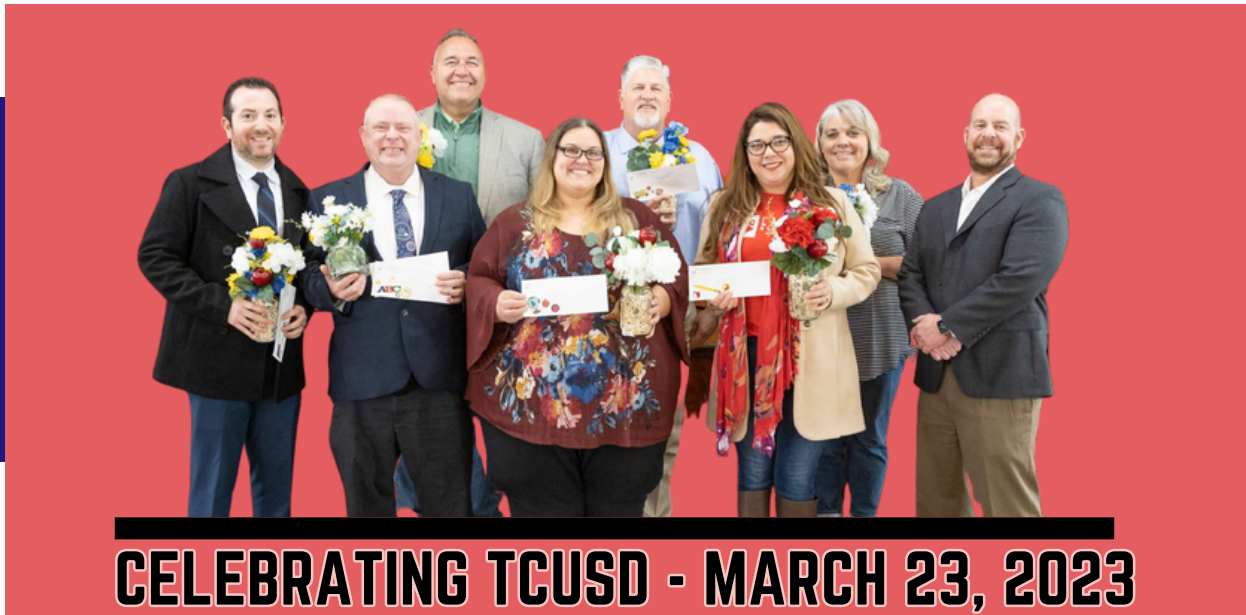

WHY WE WEAR DENIM ON APRIL 28

In 1999, the Italian Supreme Court overturned a rape conviction in which an 18-year-old student in Italy was raped by her 45-year-old driving instructor during a driving lesson in 1992. They ruled that because she was wearing tight jeans, there must have been consent. In an act of solidarity, women lawmakers wore jeans to work and protested on the steps of the Italian Supreme Court. Solidarity actions soon spread around the world, starting in Los Angeles in April 1999. We wear denim every April to support survivors and to spread awareness and education around sexual violence.

Any amount you would like to donate would be appreciated and allow the Scholarship Committee to continue this time honored tradition.



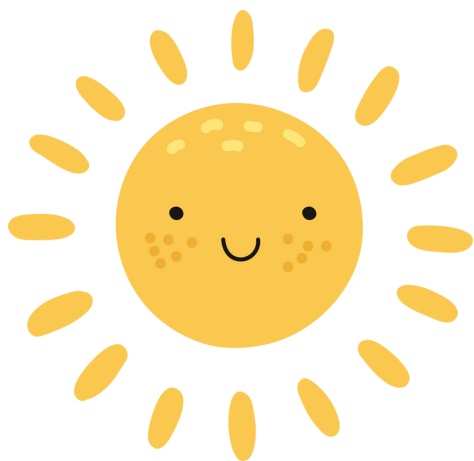
